PreK, K, and elementary students may bring their school supplies on this day from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. During your visit, you will meet your child's homeroom teacher and pay either the \$20 PreK fee, the \$35 Kindergarten fee, or the \$60.00 Grades 1-5 class fee. PreK, K, and elementary students must wear their school shirt for ID photos in the library.
