One Pager Directions

A one pager is a way to visually share key ideas and information from what you have learned. When you create a one pager, you are trying to use both visual symbols and important words to clearly and concisely share your most important takeaways with someone else.

For this one pager, I've provided you with a template.

Here is what it MUST include:

1. A border of key quotations from the text (at least 3)
2. The top half should include at least 3 symbols/images and 3 words or phrases that describe the theme of the text.
3. The bottom half should focus on important characters from the text. Please list at least 3 important details about the character/characters using words. (These could include: What is their importance to the story? How did they change throughout the story? What lesson did they learn? How did they interact with other characters in the story? How did those interactions develop the story?) You may also add any other images, drawings, or symbols that represent the reading as you wish.

Please be neat and colorful with your work!
